## **CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE red**

2005 Vintage - BLIND TASTED in January 2007

### ***Hervé Pennequin***

C - Intense red ruby color, evolving rim. N - Violet, pine tree aromas with smokiness and black fruit, spices and rosemary. P - Spicy mouth with pine tree flavors, great delicate spiciness with caramel, cacao flavors in the back, good balance.

### ***Mark Slater***

C - Brilliant, fine, lovely brick blood robe. N - Exotic fruit and citrus hints, intriguing bouquet, fine aromas of good quality, very intense, forward as well. P - Delicious, medium body, clean fruit, very interesting flavors, good quality, excellent balance, lingering in mouth long persistent finish. Very interesting, delicious and unusual wine.

### ***Andreas Larsson***

C - Medium ruby. N - Flowery and spicy nose, wild berries, complex. P - Very dense fruit, ripe tannins, good spice and great length, very long great potential!

### ***Teresa Perez***

C - Clean, brilliant, intense cherry red. N - Ripe, jammy, red fruit, plums, nice minerality, medium intensity. P - Powerful attack, very astringent in mouth, green tannins, unbalanced acidity, very short finish. Very green wine.

### ***Motohiro Okoshi***

C - Somber, strong, black garnet. N - Floral, notes of rose and rose petal, nice spice, well developed bouquet, forceful intensity. P - Aromatic attack, hint of 'eau de vie', nice astringency, good quality flavor, quite present tannins, fair acidity, balance, medium long persistence.

### ***Giuseppe Vaccarini***

C - Clean, consistent, deep ruby. N - Very fruited, lightly spiced, fine flavor quality, intense bouquet. P - Full bodied, robust, hard tannins, quite nice flavor quality, fairly balanced, long and persistent. Nice wine.
